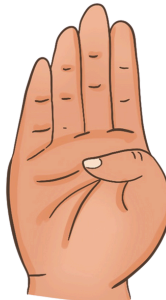


Children will strengthen their letter recognition and vocabulary by identifying objects that begin with each letter of the alphabet — all themed around hearing, sound, and everyday life.
